The position of **Staff Engineer** is open in the Engineering Department. This position will focus broadly on all aspects of the engineering department. The position reports directly to a Senior Engineer.

The applicant should have a four-year engineering sciences/engineering technology degree from an ABET accredited college/university, in Civil/Sanitary Engineering or closely related discipline. Minimum related work experience: two-five years preferred, with particular emphasis on **water/sewer** analysis and design. E.I.T. and P.E. strongly preferred. Proficiency with software including: Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Word, Microsoft Access, AutoCAD, Arc View, Arc Info, Auto Desk, WaterGEMS, Floware, PondPack, StormCAD, SWMM. Experience with public utility and environmental regulations also highly desirable. Applicant must also obtain a valid West Virginia driver's license or equivalent.

Responsibilities may include:

- Analysis/design of water/sewer/stormwater system improvements including but not limited to pipelines, pumping station and storage tanks; construction inspection and construction engineering of above.
- Contract and Project Management
- Flow measurements
- Cost estimating
- Surveying and mapping
- Contact and coordination with customers, developers, public officials and general public
- Special technical studies and project.
- Guide/assist/oversee support staff consisting of technicians, drafters, surveyors, etc
