

**ADVERTISEMENT TO BID**  
**POPENOE RUN INTERCEPTOR**  
**SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

The Morgantown Utility Board will receive sealed Bids for the Popenoe Run Interceptor System Improvements Project until 1:30 PM, September 13, 2016 at the Morgantown Utility Board Office, 278 Greenbag Road, P.O. Box 852, Morgantown, West Virginia 26507, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work includes construction of 1,342 linear feet of 36-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 1,873 linear feet of 30-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 31-feet of 15-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 67 linear feet of 10-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 127 linear feet of 8-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 371 linear feet of 8-inch HDPE fused joint gravity sewer main, 139 linear feet of 6-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 50 linear feet of 4-inch PVC gravity sewer main, 362 linear feet of 15-inch N-12 HDPE gravity storm sewer main, 22 precast concrete manholes, 1 precast concrete storm inlet, and 1 CSO concrete structure.

Bids are to be submitted in accordance with Article 13 of the "Instructions to Bidders." The two-envelope system will be used for the Bid opening procedures. All Bids submitted via U.S. Postal service must be addressed to Morgantown Utility Board, P.O. Box 852, Morgantown, West Virginia 26507-0852. All Bids hand-delivered or submitted via commercial carrier (such as UPS or Federal Express) must be addressed to Morgantown Utility Board, 278 Greenbag Road, Morgantown, West Virginia 26501.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office which is the Morgantown Utility Board, 278 Greenbag Road, Morgantown, West Virginia 26501, (304) 292-8443. A nonrefundable fee of \$100.00 will be required for Bidding Documents including full-sized drawings. Overnight mailing of Bidding Documents will not be provided.

No Bid will be received unless accompanied by a Bid Bond equal to at least five percent of the Bid, payable to the Owner as a guarantee that after a Bid is accepted, Bidder will execute and file the Agreement, Insurance Certificate, and 100% Performance and Payment Bonds within fifteen days after the Notice of Award. Bids will be accepted from only those Bidders who obtain Documents from the Owner.

Bidders who submit a Bid must be a Plan Holder of Record at the Issuing Office. Bids from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List may be returned as not being responsive. Plan Holders are requested to provide an email address if they wish to receive Addenda and other information electronically. Plan Holders are requested to designate whether they are a prime contractor, subcontractor, or supplier if they want this information posted on the Project Holders list.

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In connection with the performance of work under this Contract, Contractor shall comply with all applicable Local, State and Federal labor laws.

All Bidders are required to have a West Virginia Contractor's License per Section 21-11-11 of the West Virginia Code. The prospective Bidder's license number must be included in the first envelope as per the Bid opening checklist. All subcontractors shall furnish their WV Contractor's license number to the prime contractor prior to award of the contract.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 1:30 PM on August 31, 2016 at the Morgantown Utility Board offices at 278 Greenbag Road, Morgantown, WV. Representatives of Owner will be present to discuss the project. Bidders are required to attend and participate in the conference. Owner will transmit to all perspective Bidders of record such Addenda as Owner considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective. Bids will be accepted only from those Bidders who have attended the pre-bid conference.

The Morgantown Utility Board is exempt from West Virginia Sales Tax and, by legislative action, can now extend this tax exemption to Contractors supplying goods on their behalf. The Contractor shall coordinate with the Morgantown Utility Board the filing of any and all applications to the State of West Virginia, exempting the purchase of the specified goods from West Virginia Sales tax and hereby agrees to include the savings from such sales tax exemption in its total Bid.

The work will be substantially complete and ready for final payment in accordance with paragraph 14.07 of the General Conditions within 270 consecutive calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages will be applied if the work is not completed within the specified times.

The Morgantown Utility Board reserves the right to reject any Bid as per the provisions of WV State Code Section 5-22-2. All Bids shall remain subject to acceptance for 150 days after the time set for opening Bids.
